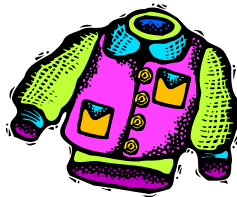
Please remember the true spirit of "thanks" and "giving" as we all have a chance to relax and reflect over the holiday season.
